1. Method of Application

2. Screening Method and Schedule

Documents will first be screened at Hosei University, with a shortlist to be decided on by the end of February 2020. The short-listed candidates will then be interviewed by the faculty member in charge via video conference, telephone, email—whichever is suitable. Following the interview, two candidates will be finally selected and recommended to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). MEXT is expected to notify us of the results by the beginning of June 2020.

3. Conditions

- (1) Period of acceptance to study: September 2020 through March 2022. Stipend begins in October 2020.
- (2) Status: Research Student (Non-degree student)
- (3) Nationality: Candidates must have nationality of counties listed in "Priority Countries" as attached
- (4) Acceptance level:
 - · Master or doctoral program at Hosei University graduate schools
 - Candidates (excluding those for English-degree program) should satisfy either of the following conditions:
 - a) Candidates have N2 or higher level of JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test), or
 - b) Candidates have completed, in Japanese language, their educational curriculum that meets admission requirements of graduate schools they wish to enroll.

Candidates for English-degree program should satisfy either of the following conditions:

- a) Candidates have B2 or higher level of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), or
- b) Candidates have completed, in English language, their educational curriculum that meets admission requirements of graduate schools they wish to enroll.

Candidates for English-degree program are advised to study Japanese language for daily life by themselves before departing for Japan. Hosei University does not offer Japanese language classes.

- Institute of Integrated Science and Technology, Graduate School of Computer and Information Sciences and Graduate School of Science and Engineering, is an English based degree program. In that program, it is not required Japanese language proficiency but students are advised to study Japanese language by themselves before departing for Japan. Hosei University does not offer any Japanese language classes.
- The research area at Hosei University is limited to the applicant's undergraduate majors or the area that he/she is currently specializing at graduate school.
- Desired area of education and research must be practicable in terms of Hosei University's curriculum/fields of study.

- It is not permitted to enter or transfer to any other universities including a Japanese language institution at another university after the applicant is determined to be a scholarship grantee.
- (5) Travel expenses: Air fare will be provided by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) or Hosei University.

(6) Tuition: Tuition fees will be covered by Hosei University.

(7) Stipend: As the amount of the stipend for 2020 has yet to be decided, please refer below to the figures for 2019.

Note that stipends may change from year to year, depending on budgetary allocations.

2019: Monthly stipend ¥143,000 (non-diploma program), ¥144,000 (Master's Degree program) ¥145,000 (Ph.D. program)

For certain specified regions, an extra \\$2000 or \\$3000 per month will be granted to both trainees and researchers alike.

(8) Accommodations:

The University can provide help in finding lodgings if needed, but basically the student is expected to find accommodations on his/her own.
