- 1. Internship/Research (non-credits)

Exchange students can have their research work or internship under supervision of a certain professor. The length and start date are negotiable, up to 1 year. The professor will support them in English. Depending on the situation, they might be able to join some courses as an auditor, but it is not assured.

2. Coursework (for credits)

Exchange students can attend some classes for credits for 1 or 2 semesters. In this case, they are requested to start and end their study according to the designated dates. In addition, it is necessary for them to have JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) Level N2 or more because most of the courses except for Graduate School of Intellectual Property are conducted only in Japanese.
