Bachelor's Degree International Program Application

Academic Year 2026 – Round 1 Admission

Thai-Nichi Institute of Technology hereby announces that Round 1 Admission of the International Program for the Academic Year 2026 will be carried out as stated below.

1. Thai-Nichi International College Programs

1. Digital Engineering Program (DGE) Faculty of Engineering	Round 1 Admission <ul style="list-style-type: none">The applicant must have graduated or is studying an M.6 in a Thai system school or graduated from an English Program (EP), Intensive English Program (IEP), Bilingual program, International school, or an overseas institution.
2. Data Science and Artificial Intelligence Program (DSA) Faculty of Information Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The applicant who submits a GED must pass 4 subjects with a minimum total score of 600 and also provide an official high school transcript of M.4 (Grade 10) or its equivalent with at least 2 terms.The applicant who applies with IGCSE must have IGCSE, GCSE or GCE 'O' Level with at least 5 subjects and GCE 'AS' Level or GCE 'A' Level with at least 3 subjects (8 subjects in total) with a minimum Grade of C or above. The applicant also has to submit an official high school transcript of M.4 (Grade 10) or its equivalent with at least 2 terms.
3. International Business and Entrepreneurship Program (IBN) Faculty of Business Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Applicants with an annual GPAX of 2.50 or higher will automatically be considered for a 25% scholarship. <p>*** Round 1 Admission: Open for all applicants with no limit, evaluated by annual average GPAX. ***</p>

2. General qualifications for all types of applicants

2.1 The student must have an identity card or be a person who is legally residing in Thailand.

2.2 The applicant must be in excellent physical and mental health without any of the following Conditions:

Leprosy, tuberculosis, lung disease, chronic alcoholism, heart problems, or drug addiction are chronic, untreatable diseases.

3. Criteria for Acceptance of Round 1 Admission

Applicants have an average annual GPAX of unlimited. In condition of applicants with an annual GPAX of 2.50 or higher will automatically be considered for a 25% scholarship and must have one of the following qualifications:

3.1 A student studying in M. 6, or grade 12, or year 13, or equivalent education at either The TNI School Network or other schools.

3.2 The school can submit a list of students with all their majors, and applicants can choose only one faculty and one program.

3.3 Applicants must have some school engagement or community activities, or have special abilities such as Japanese or other aspects that the university deems appropriate for the faculty/disciplines applying.

4. Scholarships (TNI Fund)

4.1 Round 1 Admission

1) Applicants will be assessed through an individual interview held in English only.

2) Recipients will receive a 25% tuition reduction for the full duration of the 4-year program.

3) These are bond-free scholarships with no obligation to reimburse the institution after graduation.

4.2 Conditions for Scholarship Recipients Scholarship recipients must comply with the conditions specified by the institution throughout the scholarship period as follows:

1) If the recipient students' academic standing falls below the minimum required GPAX, the scholarship will be downgraded to the lower scholarship type during the next semester until the students can meet the required GPAX for that scholarship level. Please note: Upgrading from an original to a higher scholarship type is not permitted.

2) Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change or transfer to another program or withdraw from their studies; otherwise, the scholarship will be terminated. However, students may reapply for scholarships under the terms and conditions set by TNI. If a scholarship recipient withdraws from their studies, they must inform TNI immediately with a written notice for further scholarship consideration.

3) Scholarship will not be paid in cash or checks but will be reimbursed according to the actual course registration for each semester.

4) The scholarship will be terminated without any penalty under the following conditions:

(1) Death

(2) Disability or severe illness, verified by a physician

5) Scholarship will be terminated with a penalty under the following conditions:

(1) Student's misconduct leading to TNI's decision to terminate the scholarship

(2) Changing a program or to another university without permission


- (3) Inability to complete the degree requirements within the program period
- (4) Withdrawal to study at or receive a scholarship from another university
- (5) Other actions that violate TNI scholarship regulations

5. Required Application Documents


5.1 A copy of Thai Identification Card (for Thai students) or passport (for international students).

5.2 Educational Documents:

- 1) One copy of the most recent academic transcript showing at least 4 or 5 semesters.
 - 2) One copy of an equivalency certificate certified by the Ministry of Education (for students who graduated overseas).
 - 3) One copy of IGCSE certificate:
 - (1) Once admitted, the Office of the Registrar will require the official, unopened GED test scores.
 - (2) Applicants may choose to send the official scores to the Admissions Office, which will then forward them to the Registrar.
 - 4) Standardized English Test Scores (optional, but recommended) :
 - (1) TOEIC: minimum score of 500 or higher (Listening & Reading)
 - (2) TOEFL iBT: minimum score of 45 or higher
 - (3) IELTS (Academic): minimum score of 5.0 or higher
 - (4) SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing): minimum score of 400 or higher
- 5.3 Portfolio (optional).

 **Note:** Submitting additional documents such as English test scores or a portfolio can help strengthen your application and increase your chance of receiving a 25% tuition scholarship for all 4 academic years.

8. Student registration

8.1 New Student Registration Fee and Eligibility for Enrollment. To be eligible for enrollment as a new student, the registration fee and tuition fees for the first semester of the 2026 academic year must be paid.

8.2 Students who register as new students and pay the semester fees as specified by the institute for Round 1 Admission will receive a discount of 7,000 baht applied to the final payment of the first semester (1/2026).

This special privilege is only available to students who complete their registration as new students under the Round 1 Admission category by October 5, 2025.

- 1) Payment must be made to confirm student status, or partial payment can be made through educational loan funds.
- 2) Students awarded a 25% scholarship must choose between a credit exemption and the discount.

9. Tuition Fees

Those who have been selected to study must pay the registration fee, student card fee, guide fee, tuition, and credits for the first semester of the 2026 academic year, which are estimated costs listed below.
