Monday 15 August 2016

Wednesday 17 August 2016

I had an appointment with a TTI student on 9.00 am at the lobby. There were 2 guys at the lobby once I went to down stair for check out at 8.45 am. Then we were greeting one another. I was surprised that they came early before meeting. So that why they say Japanese people are very punctual. Even trains, bus or taxi always on time. 






Sunday 21 August 2016
