- 1. Accepting applications from your university, PGP will choose the final candidates through document screening and online interview including presentation to be held on November 20 of 2020 and recommend them to MEXT.
- 2. Please note that the applicant should contact one of the PGP faculty members and receive an acceptance permission from his or her intended supervisor at MuroranIT in advance of application process. Thus, instruct your applicant to have a full discussion with a PGP faculty regarding acceptance permission and research plan by the due date of application as specified below.
- 3. Please note that the deadline for applications is October 7, 2020.
 *In case it is difficult to submit the documents due to COVID-19, please inform us in advance.
- 4. Priority countries (Southeast Asia, Southwest Asia, Mongolia): India, Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Nepal, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, Maldives, Mongolia, Laos
- 5. In parallel with the selection of the scholarship, the admission application and entrance procedure for doctoral Course is also necessary and should be done by the scholar applicant. The application period for admission to the Docroral Course is: from 1 October 2020 to 7 October 2020.
